Overview

The DSEX closed at 4,586.3 points, up by 9.2 points. The total transaction was worth BDT 4.3 bn.

Price of 147 issues appreciated whereas 128 issues declined and 48 others remained unchanged.

Market Commentary:

Stocks have moved mostly higher during today's trading, adding to the meager gains posted in last three sessions. Index started negative but after mid-hour of trading session bargain hunter began to take position and eventually Index ended at 4,577.1, an increase by 9.2 points. Gainers outperformed the Losers by 147 to 128.

Turnover, a major indicator increased notably by 26.7% to 4.3 bn. Engineering sector showed the highest turnover followed by Pharma, Bank and Textile Sectors.


On the macroeconomic front, Net sales of savings instruments hit a record high in fiscal 2015-16; doubled than Government target of sales.

Telecommunication sector performed particularly well today. Among the other prominent sectors Bank, and Insurance have outperformed the market today while the rest underperformed.

BSRMLTD was the daily turnover leader contributing 3.1% to total turnover and also posting 1.4% negative price return.

BD placed 19th in global financial inclusion progress

Bangladesh has been ranked 19th, scoring 66% in financial inclusion progress among many countries in the world while Kenya topped the list with 84% score, according to a global study report

The 2016 Brookings Financial and Digital Inclusion Project (FDIP) report revealed recently evaluates access to and usage of affordable financial services by underprivileged people across 26 geographically, politically and economically diverse countries.

Sales of savings tools hit record

Net sales of savings instruments hit a record high in fiscal 2015-16, as investors were lured in by interest rates which are 5 percentage points higher than those offered by commercial banks on term deposits.

The amount was more than double the target set by the government for the fiscal year: it stood at Tk 33,688.6 crore -- the highest in the country's history -- against the target of Tk 15,000 crore.

"The high interest rates are the main reason for this surge in sales in recent years," said Ayezuddin Ahmed, director of administration and public relations at the National Savings Directorate.
